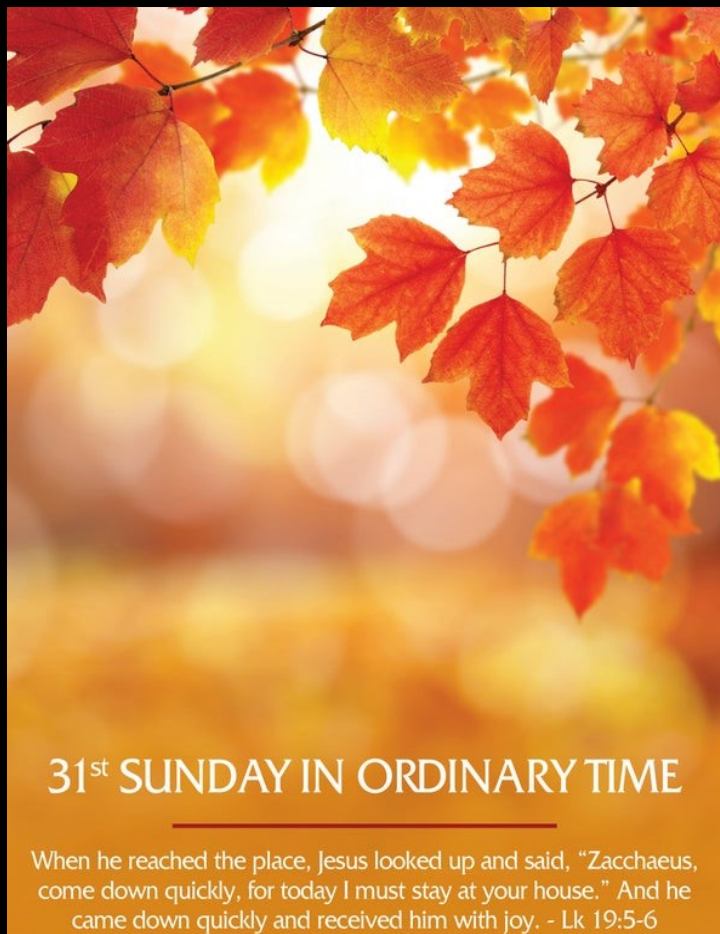

## **From your pastor . . .**

This column will reproduce much of last Sunday's column concerning the progress in the Inspired by the Spirit Campaign.

We presently have raised \$400,487 or 83.4% of the total goal through gifts and pledges. This amount has come from 72 parishioners which constitutes 29% of those parishioners (248) who give \$50 or more annually for parish support.

This is a very generous response from our parish. Thank you. In the days to come, I wish to encourage the remaining 71% of parishioners to also respond. We are hoping to bring the active part of the campaign to a conclusion by Thanksgiving. Gifts and pledges will be accepted after Thanksgiving, and throughout the renovation process.

This past week I signed a contract for the removal of the pews as well as the refinishing they will be undergoing. This is scheduled to begin the week of January 15<sup>th</sup>. At this time, I am confident that with what the campaign has raised thus far and will continue to raise there will be sufficient funds carry out the entire project of renovation in the nave of the church.

Having the support of the majority, if not all, parishioners is very important for this improvement of our parish church. This is our spiritual home where we come to be nourished by God's Word and Sacraments. This is the place where you and your family members were perhaps baptized, received your First Holy Communion and First Penance, were confirmed, and celebrated the Sacrament of Marriage. Also, Saint Mary's may have been the church where a family member's Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated and where your own will be celebrated. Just as your own family home at times needs to be repaired and renovated, so too does your spiritual home.

I take this opportunity to express my gratitude to all who have made contributions thus far through the campaign. Because of your generosity, we will be setting into motion over the next weeks the renovation that appears in the campaign brochure and the appears on the renderings near the entrances to the church.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.
