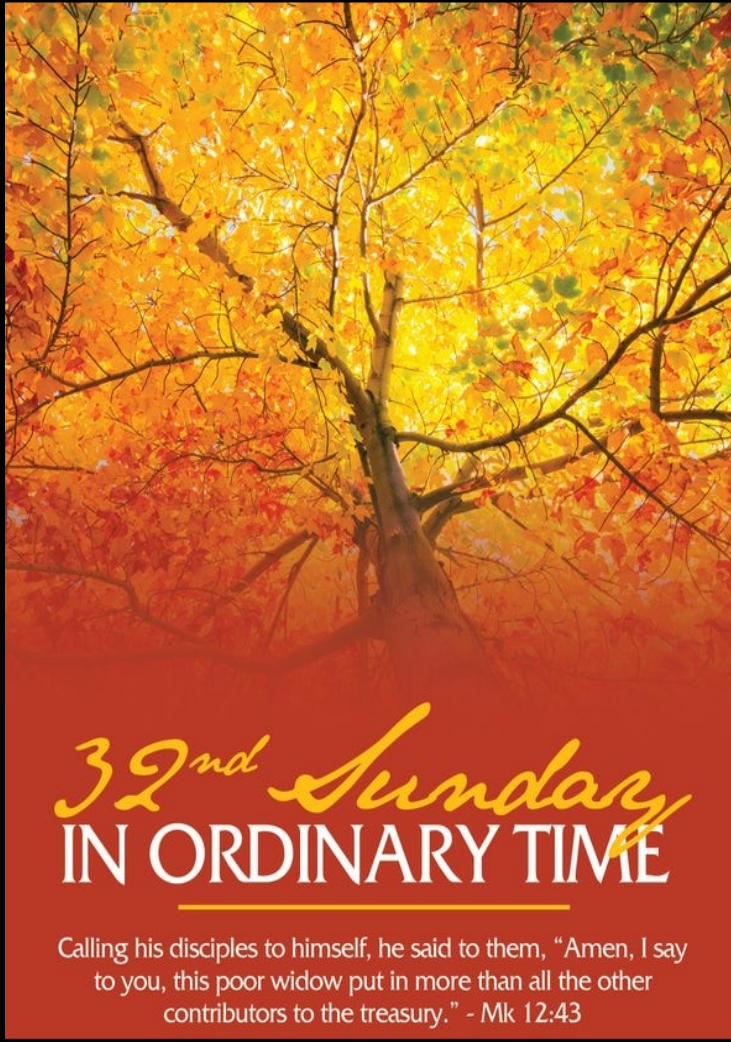

From you pastor . . .

A number of you have asked me if the majority of parishioners have returned to celebrating the Sunday Mass. They indicate that they are able to observe the number of parishioners who attend the Mass they attend, but they don't know about the other two Masses.

For the past ten years, the Diocese has asked all parishes to engage in a Mass count during the month of October. This has been done from the vantage point of the choir loft where volunteers are able to count without having to walk through the church while counting, which would be a significant distraction.

The October 2021 count has been done for the first four Sundays of October. (This year there was five Sundays, however the Diocese only asks for the first four.) The numbers are as follows:

Saturday, October 2nd, 5:15 Mass – 92
Sunday, October 3rd, 8:00 a.m. Mass - 96
Sunday October 3rd, 10:30 a.m. Mass -83
Total - 271

Saturday, October 9th, 5:15 p.m. Mass -89
Sunday, October 10th, 8:00 a.m. Mass – 79
Sunday, October 10th, 10:15 a.m. Mass -91
Total – 259

Saturday, October 16, 5:15 p.m. Mass – 76
Sunday, October 17, 8:00 a.m. Mass – 112
Sunday, October 17, 10:30 a.m. Mass – 87
Total -275

Saturday, October 23rd, 5:15 p.m. Mass – 105
Sunday, October 24th, 8:00 a.m. Mass – 122
Sunday, October 24th, 10:30 a.m. Mass – 85
Total – 312

For your information, the church holds 368 persons, (46 pews x 8). If you compare the number of people attending each Mass with the capacity of the Church, it is possible to be distanced from other worshippers if that is a concern.

The number of parishioners attending now is less than during pre-pandemic days. However, parishioners are slowly and consistently returning, which is a good sign. I hope and pray all will return soon.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.

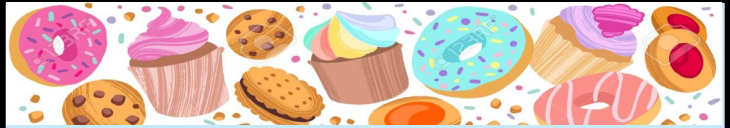

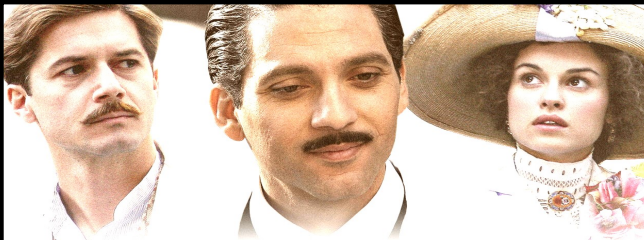
