From your pastor . . . With this column I wish to encourage you if you have not done so, that during Lent you make a thorough and contrite confession of your sins in the Sacrament of Penance. The Sacrament of Penance provides for the communication of redeeming grace for those sins that have been committed after the Sacrament of Baptism. Our Lord Jesus instituted this Sacrament on the evening of the day of His resurrection when he met with his Apostles in the upper room where they had previously eaten the Last Supper with Our Lord before his suffering and death.

Listed below are the days and times that are being made available for Confession. Below that is the “Order for Making a Good Confession,” which we utilize here at Saint Mary’s Parish. You are invited to clip it out and bring it with you to the confessional. Be certain to make a good and thorough examination of your conscience before entering the confessional. This can be done earlier in your home and so that it is easier to remember, you can write your sins out and bring that memo to the confessional. Before making an examination of conscience, pray to God the Holy Spirit, who has revealed himself to be of great assistance in remembering the truths of our Faith brought to our world by Jesus Christ.

Order of Confession

Priest: In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen

Penitent: Bless me Father for I have sinned. My last confession was _____ ago and these are my sins. (At this point you make a complete confession of your sins to the best of your recollection.) . . . **and I am sorry for these and all the sins of my life.**

(The priest will give you words of counsel and assign your penance)

Penitent: (Recites this Act of Contrition or any other one they may wish to use)

O My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. And I detest all my sins because of thy just punishments. But most of all because they offend you my God who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

Priest: (Recites the prayer of absolution) God the Father of mercies, through the death and resurrection of his Son has reconciled the world to himself and sent the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins; through the ministry of the Church may God give you pardon and peace, and I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Spirit.

Penitent: Amen.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.

Penitent: And His mercy endures forever.

Priest: The Lord has freed you from your sins. Go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.

(You now leave the confessional to carry out your assigned penance.)
