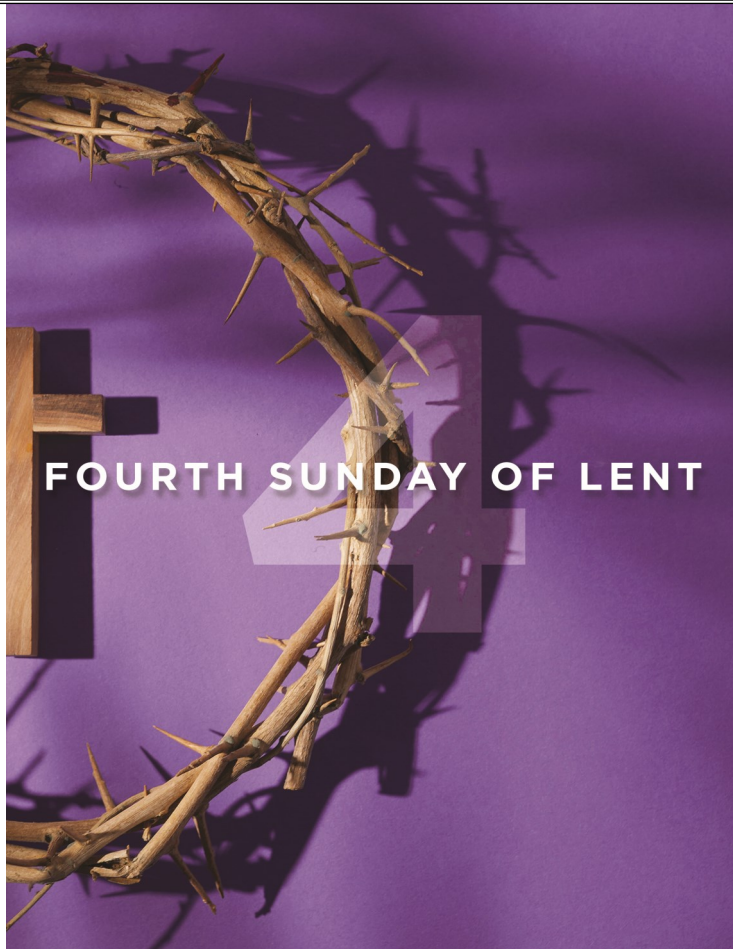

From your pastor . . .

It is almost certain that we will be in the church to celebrate Palm Sunday on April 2nd. (It may be that we will return the Sunday before – known as Passion Sunday – the 5th Sunday of Lent – but I am not as certain about it as I am about Palm Sunday). Stay tuned.

We will have a short prayer of thanksgiving and blessing of the newly renovated interior immediately before the three Masses begin on Palm Sunday, this will then lead into the blessing of the Palms.

The extended Lenten confession schedule will be during Holy Week and will take place in the newly renovated church. All of the lights of the Church will be on during the time for confessions so that parishioners may have time to better appreciate the work that has been done over the past weeks.

The Confession schedule will be:

Monday, April 3, 6:30 – 8:00 p.m.

Tuesday, April 4, 5:00 – 6:30 p.m.

Wednesday, April 5, 5:00 -7:00 p.m.

The schedule for the Triduum (the three great days of Christ's redemptive passion) are as follows:

April 6 -Holy Thursday – 7:00 p.m. The Mass of the Lord's Supper (with foot washing). The Church will remain open after Mass until 10:00 p.m. for keeping vigil with our Lord in prayer as he asked his disciples to do with him while in the Garden of Gethsemane.

April 7 – Good Friday – 1:00 p.m. This is a day of fasting (one full meal allowed) and abstinence (refraining from eating meat).

April 8 – Holy Saturday – 8:00 p.m. – The Easter Vigil Mass (will include incense). At this Mass Nicholas Perna and Grant Worthington will make a profession of Faith and be received into full communion with the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.

Easter Sunday: 8:00 a.m. Mass (no incense), 10:30 a.m. Mass (with incense).

We look forward to celebrating Easter Solemnities in the Church. Please continue to pray for a successful completion of all the work.

Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.

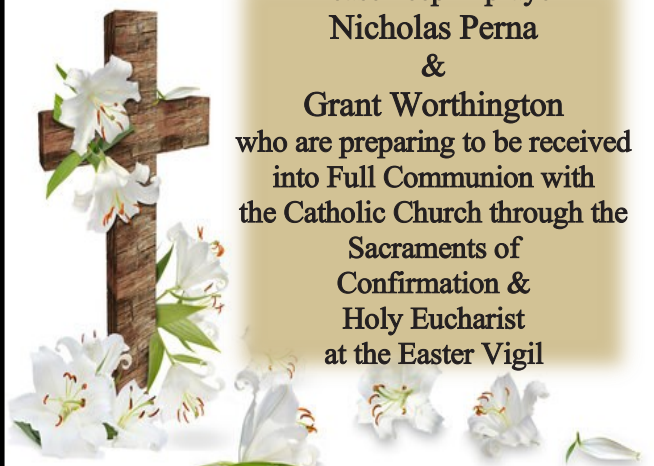
