## **From your pastor . . .**

This coming Sunday, June 1-2, when you come into the church from the fourth street entrance and through the main vestibule, you will see a display of various sacred images carved from olive wood from the Holy Land. This display is being presented by Blest Art which serves as a conduit in the United States for those Christians in the Holy Land, living close to Bethlehem, who carve these images for their livelihood. Blest Art is the marketing arm of a co-op of artisans. Because of the terrible conflicts involving Israel and Palestine (Gaza) the number of pilgrims to the Holy Land has significantly diminished. Whatever you may choose to purchase will adorn your homes (or as a gift to someone) as well as support these Christian artisans of that region.

Below is a copy of last week's column that included these renderings of the communion rail that should be arriving in 4-8 weeks. I will do this again in my next column so that as many parishioners as possible are able to view this addition to the sanctuary.

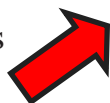
