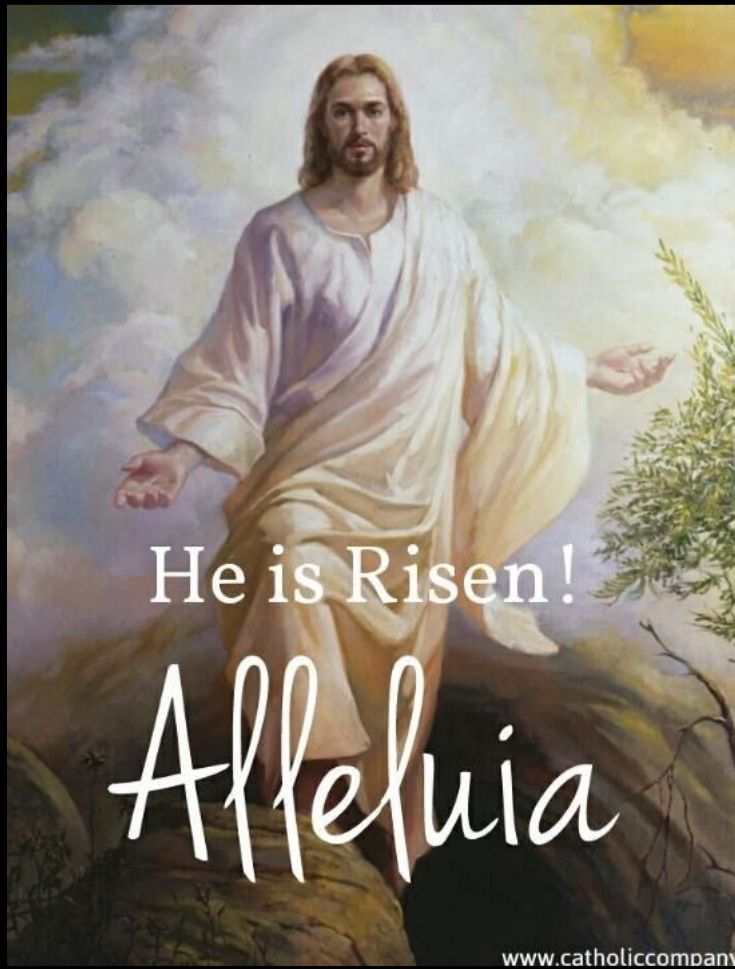

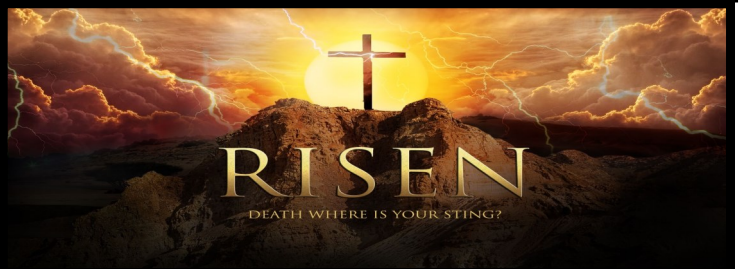

From your pastor . . .

He has risen. Alleluia!

With this ancient Easter proclamation, I extend to all of you a most Blessed Easter. I pray that after a good forty days of Lent, most of it in the inconvenience of the gymnasium you are able to celebrate with a deep faith Christ's resurrection and the hope that it brings to your life and our world. May the graces of this holy event of Easter be with you throughout the Easter Season.

Congratulations and welcome to Grant Worthington and Nicholas Perna who entered into full communion with the Catholic Church at the Easter vigil. We welcome the two of them and look forward to their participation with us in the days and years to come.

I extend a special thank you to all who were involved in assisting with our Holy Week liturgies, to the ushers, readers, servers, our choir, vocalists, and accompanists. The presence of the fourth degree Knights of Columbus was very much appreciated. I offer a particular thank you to Deacon Tully who along with many other liturgical responsibilities provides direction to the servers during these liturgies. Thank you to those who were involved in decorating the Church and the sanctuary making it look its very best, as well as to all who made donations to cover the cost of the beautiful flowers that beautify the sanctuary. Our Holy Week and Easter celebrations have taken on a particular joyfulness by being able to worship in the newly redecorated nave and sanctuary. We give thanks to God for what seems to be a fruitful endeavor that will serve our parish for many years to come.

We have some important celebrations coming soon to our parish. Next weekend, we celebrate Mercy Sunday. As we have done in past years, we will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy approximately five minutes after each Mass is concluded. Please plan to remain afterward to pray the chaplet.

On Sunday, April 23rd at the 10:30 a.m. Mass we shall celebrate First Holy Communion for those children who have reached the age of seven years and who have made their First Confession. There will be a practice on Saturday, April 22, for the First Communicants and their parents at 10:00 a.m. We look forward to this wonderful day with the children.

On Thursday, May 4th, our parish will host the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation at 6:30 p.m. for the youth of the parish as well as the parishes of Hillsboro, Wonewoc, Cazenovia, Keysville, Lone Rock and Viroqua. The practice for this occasion will take place one hour (5:30 p.m.) before the beginning of the Mass. **Unfortunately, due to health concerns, Bishop Callahan will not be in attendance for Confirmation.** He has delegated the authority to your pastor to administer the Sacrament. I admit that I am disappointed that the bishop is unable to attend. It would have been wonderful for him to see the improvements made to our Church over these past ten weeks. Nevertheless, like First Holy Communion this too will be a wonderful occasion for our parish and the young people who will be participating. A light reception in the undercroft will follow the Mass.

Finally, I wish to invite all of you to come to the Richland Center Community Center on Saturday, April 29, for our parish's Sportsman's Extravaganza. There will be good food and drink along with opportunities to win various guns, bows, optics, knives, and other items. Our PCCW ladies will be hosting a jewelry table. There will be numerous door prizes and no admission charge. The doors open at 6:00 p.m. The final raffle for the evening is a choice between 40 acres of hunting land in northern Wisconsin or a \$25,000 cash prize. We ask that our parish workers please arrive by 5:00 p.m. If you would like to volunteer to participate at the event, please call the rectory. This is a very good fundraiser for our parish and an enjoyable time for those who attend. Tell your family and friends to come.

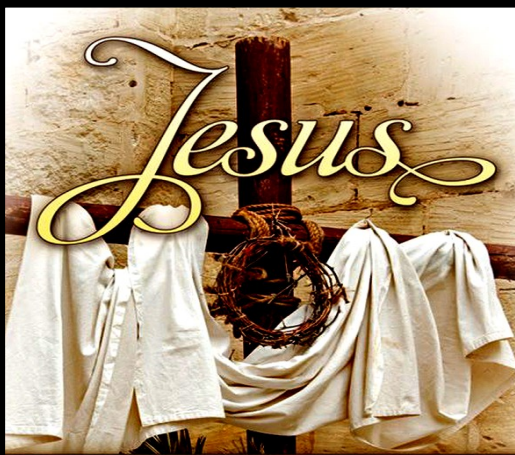

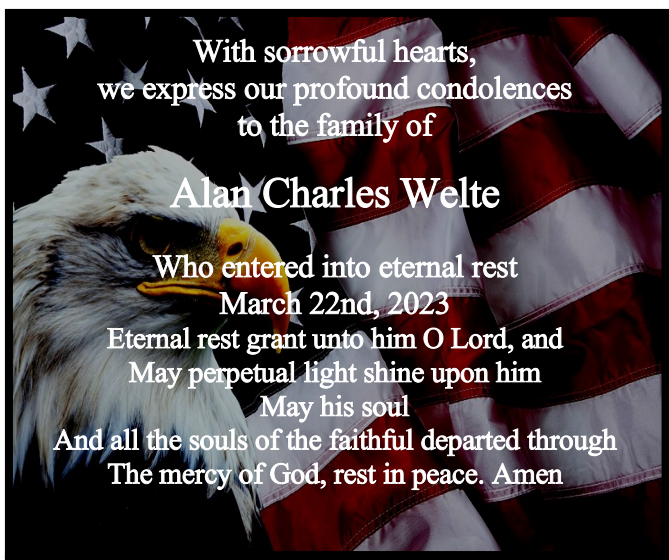
