

From your pastor ...

I again take this opportunity to wish you all a blessed Christmas season and New Year. We are in the heart of the Christmas season with today's celebration of the Feast of the Holy Family of Nazareth. On January 1st (Wednesday) we shall celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, which is a Holy Day of Obligation. Two Masses will be celebrated to assist you in attending Mass: 5:15 p.m. on New Year's Eve (Tuesday), 9:00 a.m. on New Years Day (Wednesday). Please don't allow yourself to begin the New Year in the wrong way by deliberating missing Holy Mass. Next Sunday, (January 5th) we will celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany that recalls the arrival of the three Magi to Bethlehem. The Christmas season will come to its conclusion with the celebration of the Baptism of our Lord on Sunday, January 12th.

On this Feast of the Holy Family, we pray in a particular way through the intercession of the Holy Family of Nazareth, constituted of Jesus, Mary and Joseph for the well-being and protection of the families of our parish and families throughout our county, state and nation. The family is the first and primary social cell of the larger society. Without having strong and intact families our nation suffers gravely. Pope Saint John Paul II wrote these important and prophetic words, "The future of humanity passes by way of the family." One of the most important ways that families are strengthened is through the Catholic Faith and the Church. Our parish and our Catholic school in particular are here to serve as an essential help to parents and families.

I wish to use the remainder of this column to give a brief financial update concerning the progress of the Diocesan Annual Appeal that is taking place throughout our Diocese and within our parish. Because the bulletin must be published at an earlier date than normal during Christmas and New Years, this accounting is from December 17, 2024, so by the time you read this in all likelihood the numbers have changed.

Goal: \$32,715.00

Total Pledged and Received: \$34,600.00

Amount Received: \$31,010.00 Over/under goal: (\$1,705). Average gift amount: \$313.30

Thank you to all who have given generously to the Appeal. As you can ascertain, at this point we have pledged above the goal that was assigned to us. We will continue to keep the campaign going with the hope that more parishioners will respond with the same generosity as those who have already responded.

May you enjoy this New Year's Day with family and friends. Until I write again, may God bless you and all the parishioners of Saint Mary's Parish.
