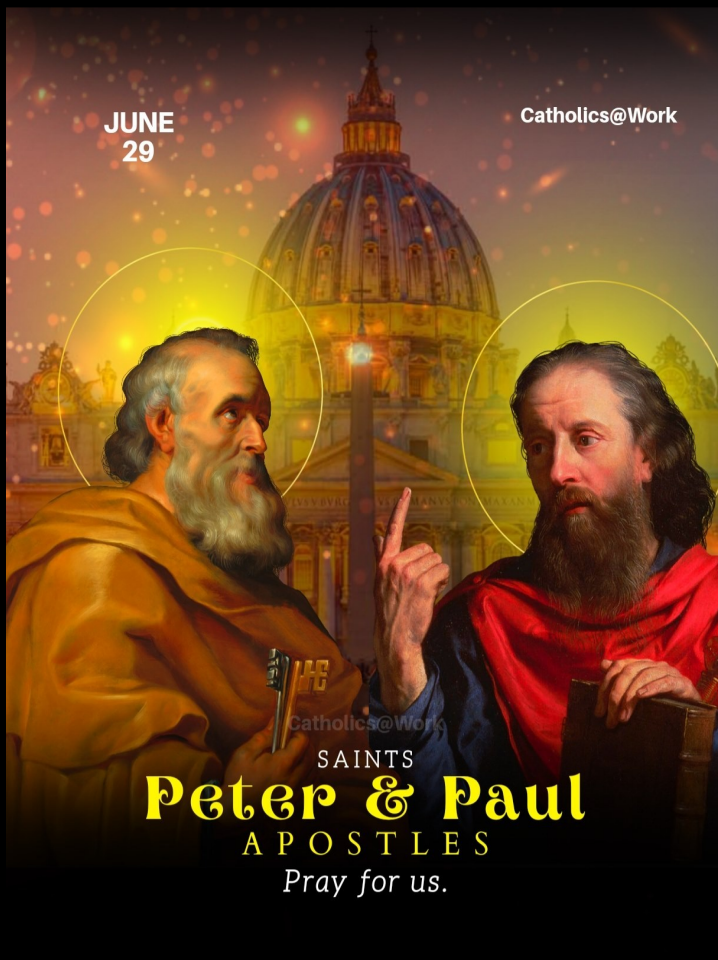

From your pastor . . .

This will be my last column written as your pastor to appear in the bulletin in that on Tuesday, July 1, I will no longer be the pastor of Saint Mary's. Father Nate Kuhn will become the new pastor that day. It was on July 1, 2011, that I became the pastor and celebrated my first Mass at Saint Mary's Church. It has been a good 14 years, and I give thanks to God that Bishop Callahan sent me to serve here in Richland Center. It has been hard work throughout the years but also work that has been meaningful and rewarding. I especially give thanks to God for the cooperation I received from the parishioners of St. Mary's. I am thankful for the generosity of so many so that we were able to carry out some important building and renovations projects. I am recalling the addition to the school, the installation of the elevator in the church, the new steps, ramp and railings at the entrance of the Church, the resurfacing of the parking lot/playground, the new roof on the rectory garage and attachment between the garage and church, new windows throughout the entire rectory, the painting and redecoration of the Church sanctuary, including the marble tile flooring, the marble ambo (lectern) and the communion rail, the new porcelain flooring under the pews and in the aisles as well as the reconditioning of the pews. There are many other projects that have taken place especially in the school that are too numerous to mention.

Comfort me in my afflictions.

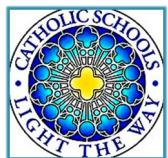
Give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death.
