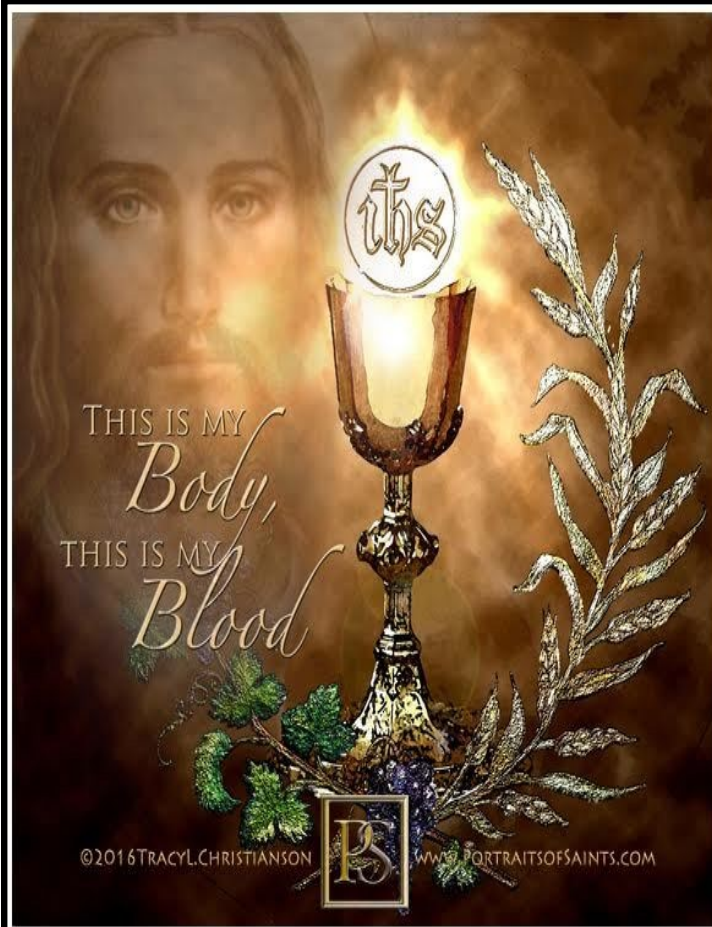

From your pastor . . .

As I mentioned in my last column, I am sharing with you before I depart as your pastor (June 30th), an accounting of the present assets that Saint Mary's parish has available at this time. What is shared with you in this column is what was shared in the last column. I do this with the recommendation of the parish finance council that met on June 5th. The membership of the finance council consists of Gary Peckham, Richard Wastlick, Brian Kennedy, Tom Delagrave, Vicki (Faber) Peckham and Steve Bauer.

I begin with some wonderful news in terms of two financial gifts that have come to the parish during this past month. First, Eva Shilling gifted our parish from her estate the amount of \$134,406.18. This gift has no restrictions on how it can be used in the parish. Its use can be determined by the pastor in consultation with the parish finance council. The second piece of wonderful news is a gift of \$100,000 from an anonymous donor. This gift has the restriction that it be used for furthering the education mission of the Catholic school. This is to be done with close consultation with the school's principal and always with the final approval of the pastor.

What follows is a listing of our parish assets, including these two gifts mentioned above. All the amounts listed below are current to June 5, 2025 (the date of the last finance council meeting).

Education Fund at the Diocese of La Crosse - \$248,169.32
Scrip checking - \$11,109.69
Scrip Inventory - \$21,310
Trust for perpetual care of cemetery – held with Trustpoint - \$134,174.24 (restricted)
Cemetery checking - \$39,851.23
Endowment Trust – held with Stifel Investments managed by Kevin Bay - \$881,924 (restricted)

Total restricted - \$1,016,098.24
Total non-restricted - \$1,534,720.34

Asset Grand Total - \$2,550,818.58

Total parish income - \$1,958,197.47

I present this accounting to you on the event of my leaving as your pastor so that you can ascertain the financial condition of Saint Mary's Parish. I also take this opportunity to express my deep appreciation for the continual generosity on the part of so many parishioners over the past fourteen years that allows me to leave Saint Mary's with the knowledge that its financial condition is very good.
